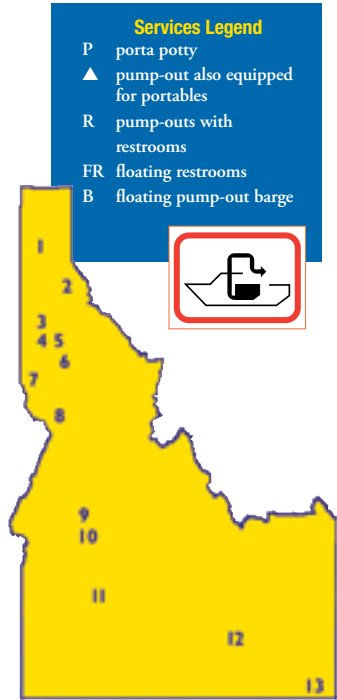

1. Each person on a PWC must *wear* a USCG–approved PFD at all times.
2. Those 14 years of age or younger must *wear* an approved PFD at all times when underway in a vessel 19 feet or less in length.
3. Required on inboard and stern drives only.
4. Required on federally controlled waters. Visit www.parksandrecreation.idaho.gov for the list of federally controlled waters in Idaho.
5. It is strongly recommended that PWCs are not operated after dark. However, if a PWC is operated at night, it must come equipped by the manufacturer with the required navigation lights.
