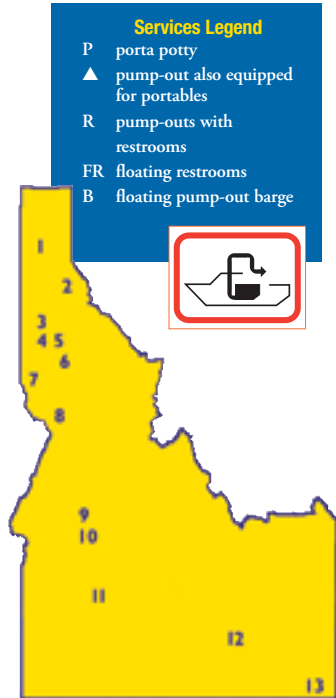

# Idaho Required Equipment Checklist

1. Each person on a PWC must *wear* a USCG–approved PFD at all times.
2. Those 14 years of age or younger must *wear* an approved PFD at all times when underway in a vessel 19 feet or less in length.
3. Required on inboard and stern drives only.
4. Required on federally controlled waters. Visit [www.parksandrecreation.idaho.gov](http://www.parksandrecreation.idaho.gov) for the list of federally controlled waters in Idaho.
5. It is strongly recommended that PWCs are not operated after dark. However, if a PWC is operated at night, it must come equipped by the manufacturer with the required navigation lights.
